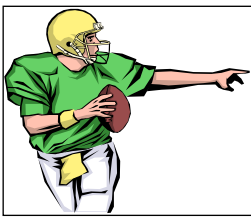

Next year's 4th, 5th, 6th, and 7th grader:

You will be introduced to football in your own separate session at one of the state's top camps. You will learn the correct way under the watchful eyes of Penn's coaching staff and players. This camp is not a physical contact or conditioning camp. With one coach for every five campers, there will be instruction for all 22 positions as well as all of the kicking specialties. Next year's 7th grade boys are given the option of concentrating on one or two positions of their choice. There will also be carefully supervised touch football games. Remember, sound fundamentals and individual instruction are essential in the formative years for high school and college success.

Next year's 8th and 9th grader:

You will get an edge with a week of individual concentrated teaching. You will be weeks ahead of the non-camper.
