The 2020-2021 school year brought numerous challenges; Playing, coaching, and supervising high school athletics in an uncertain landscape was no exception. Despite the uncertainty of it all, Penn High School Athletic teams and student-athletes continued to excel both on and off the field of play. Overall, our teams won close to 80% of all varsity contests for the year. In addition, more than 60 student-athletes earned academic all-state honors, 15 of 20 IHSAA teams won their sectional in post-season competition (including all 9 girls teams!), 54 senior student-athletes made commitments to compete in college athletics, and our 1,000+ student-athletes earned an average GPA of 3.58, a full half grade higher than the overall student body.

Our Boys Swimming 200 Freestyle Relay team successfully defended their 2020 State Title and freshman Lily Christianson sprinted to an individual Girls Swimming State Title in the 50 Freestyle. Our student-athletes continued to shine despite the adversities and challenges they faced.

The Penn Athletic Department and coaches across our 20+ sports teams are now busy preparing for the opening of Indiana high school extracurricular activities for the 2021-2022 school year! Kingsmen Nation is excited to come out and support their classmates in a big way! With your continued support we hope to continue providing these students with outstanding experiences through education-based athletics.

One important way to support our teams is to purchase an **All Sports Pass for the 2021-2022 school year!** Your support is necessary for our continued success because in Indiana (except for facilities, some travel and coaching salaries) HS Athletic Programs are NOT supported by tax dollars. All equipment, supplies, and other accessories associated with any of our athletic teams must come from gate receipts (ticket/sport pass sales), fundraisers, and donations. Another advantage of purchasing and using an all sports pass is that there is no exchange of money with the ticket taker. You simply show or have your card scanned and enter the Penn athletic venue.

I hope you will consider this offer to support our 1,000 plus student-athletes through the purchase of the All Sports Pass for the 2021-22 school year. We look forward to hosting you and your family at our events.

Please include a self-addressed stamped envelope if you want your passes mailed back to you. Otherwise all passes will be available for pick-up in the athletic office beginning August 10th from 8:30am – 3:30pm.

* **FRESHMEN STUDENTS ONLY** can purchase an ALL-SPORT PASS that is good for all four (4) years of high school for \$150.00. Students will receive a new card each year that reflects the current school year.

All-Sport passes are valid for fall, winter, and spring home, regular season contests.

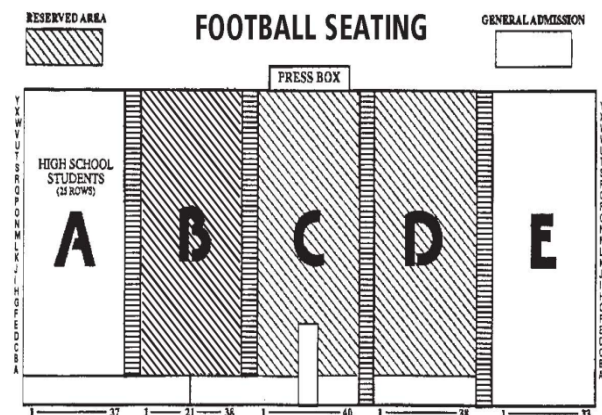
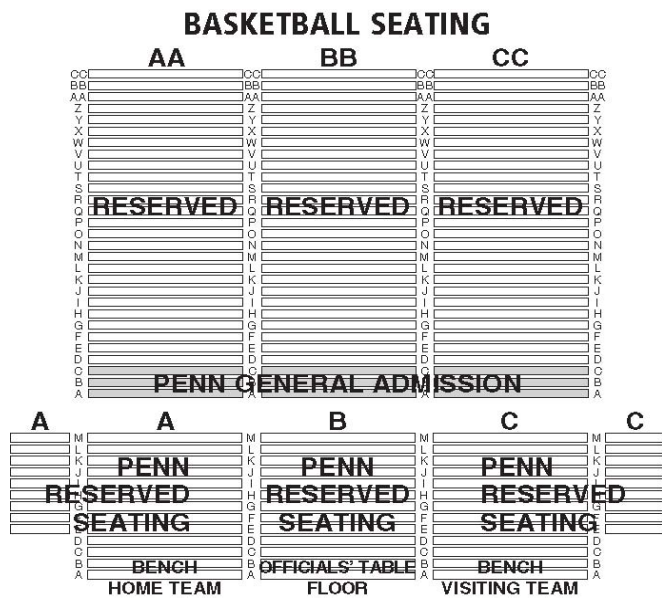
Please note that beginning October 31st All-Sport passes will have a pro-rated purchase option.
Adult - \$50.00 and Student - \$30.00

MISUSE OR ABUSE OF CARDS WILL LEAD TO LOSS OF USE AND CARD DEACTIVATION

- There is no deadline for purchasing passes. Requests will be processed in the order in which they are received. Priority for seating requests will be given to previous ticket holders if received prior to July 31st. **If you request group seating, all orders must be sent in together. If not, your request cannot be granted.**
- BE SURE TO ENCLOSE A SELF-ADDRESSED, STAMPED ENVELOPE WITH YOUR ORDER! Please take into consideration the amount of sport passes you are ordering when choosing the size of the return envelope and the amount of postage. Sport passes will be available starting on Tuesday, August 10th, 2021. They will be mailed to your home address. If you did not include a self-addressed stamped envelope, your passes will be available for pick up in the Athletic Office at Penn High School. Please specify if you want student(s) seated with adults in reserved sections. Otherwise, the student ticket will be unreserved.
- When stating seat preference give general directions for a second choice. For example, “Don’t put me lower than row “H” or “Put us in the top five rows”. This will be helpful in case the seat you asked for is taken. It is unnecessary to put row M, for example, as a second choice if you specify row N as your first choice. We will try to seat you as close to your first request as possible.

Benefits of Having an All-Sports Pass

- Admits you to all HOME, regular season contests. It is important to note that All-Sports passes cannot be used at State Series Play-Off Contests or NIC Conference Championship events.
- The right to reserved seating for home football, boys basketball, and girls basketball games (if you prefer).
- PLEASE NOTE that if a ticket is lost or stolen there is a pro-rated fee for each card.
