Penn High School Athletic teams and student-athletes excelled both on and off the field of play during the 2022-2023 school year. Overall, our teams won close to 80% of all varsity contests for the year. In addition, more than 50 student-athletes earned academic all-state honors, 37 senior student-athletes made commitments to compete in college athletics, and our 1,000+ student-athletes earned an average GPA of 3.57, a full half grade higher than the overall student body.

Junior Lily Christianson sprinted to her 3rd individual Girls Swimming State Title in three years. Our girls wrestling team won their 6th IHSGW State Title in 7 years. Markus Burton completed a legendary high school basketball career by finishing 20th all-time in Indiana career scoring and was named our school's 1st Indiana Mr. Basketball as the team played in front of sold out home crowds. Penn student-athletes competed successfully across the board, with 15 of 20 IHSAA teams winning their sectional in post-season competition. Our Softball and Baseball teams both won state championships, only the 2nd time in IHSAA history one school has won both in the same school year!

The Penn Athletic Department and coaches across our 20+ sports teams are now busy preparing for the opening of Indiana high school extracurricular activities for the 2023-2024 school year. Kingsmen Nation is excited to come out and support their classmates in a big way! With your continued support we hope to continue providing these students with outstanding experiences through education-based athletics.

Another advantage of purchasing and using an all sports pass is that there is no exchange of money with the ticket taker. You simply show or have your card scanned and enter the Penn athletic venue.
