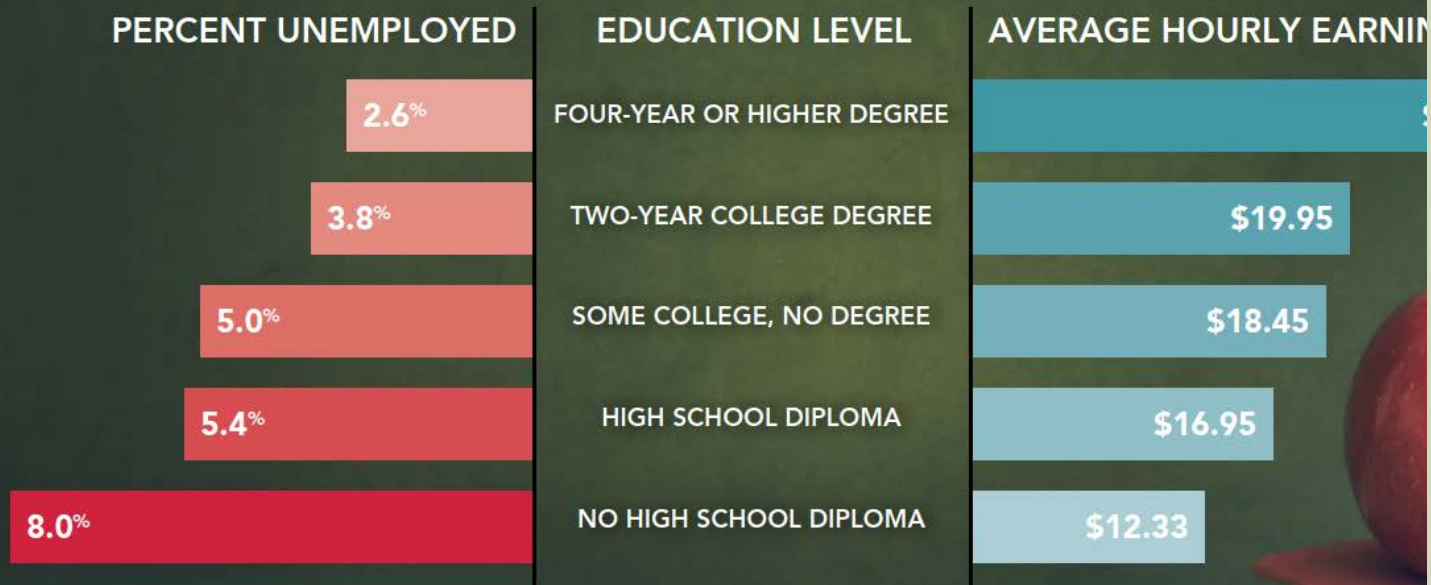

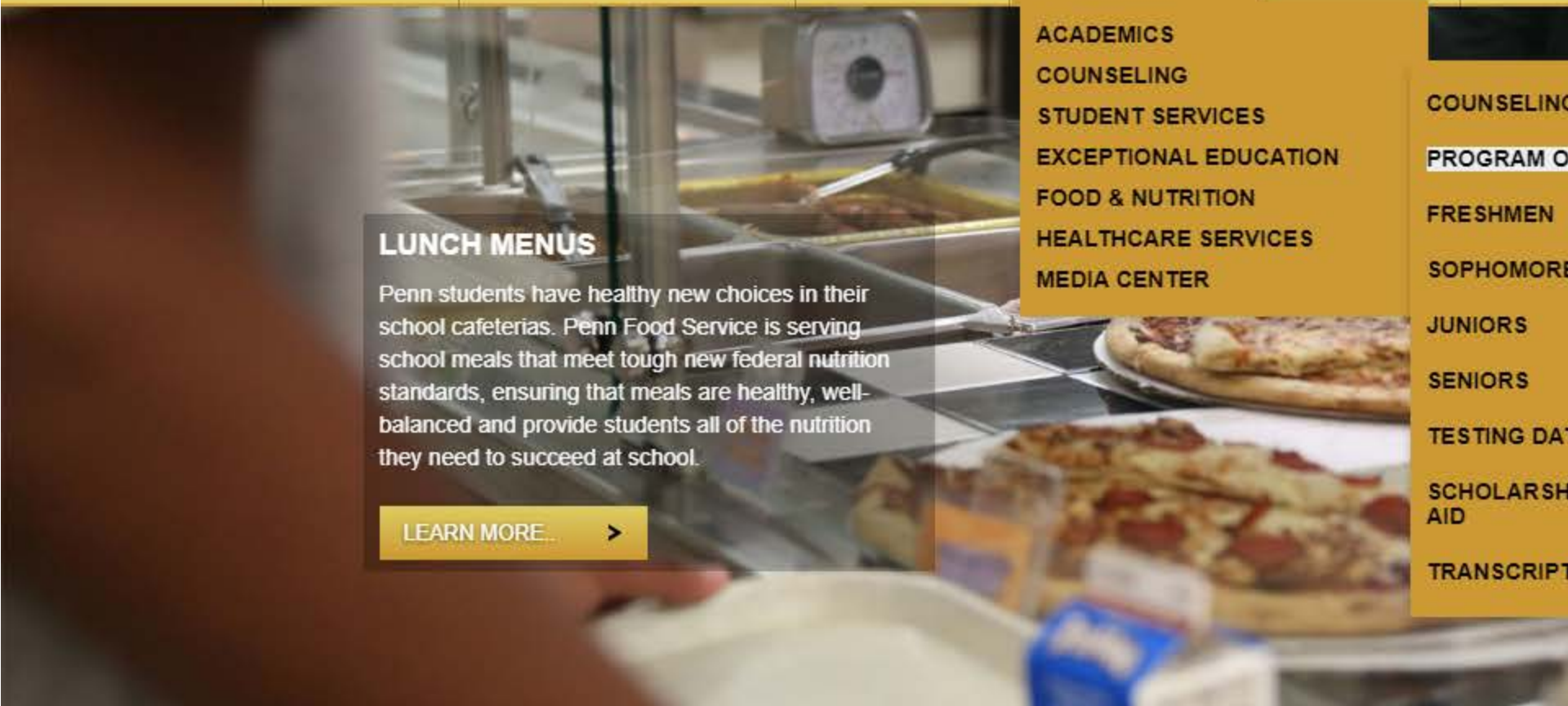
LUNCH MENUS
