Many Changes for this year!! Ski Club Sign-up instructions: FOLLOW ALL STEPS:

1. Go to Swiss Valley club store on their website to purchase your ski pass. Many options to choose from. Purchase your pass by Nov. 8th for the cheapest price. Last day to register is Dec. 1st or before if sold out. Only 100 spots available. Click here for website or scan the QR code on brochure. Find Penn High School in the alphabetical drop downs. Login with the following information:

2. What ticket to buy for PENN STUDENTS: we only go 4 nights so the best ticket to buy if you only want 4 nights is a 4-visit club pass. However, if you want to ski more and provide your own transportation for non club nights consider the following: Once -A-Week pass or a Gold pass (which is a season pass).

Your family and friends may also purchase passes at a reduced rate thru the Club store. However, they cannot ride the bus. They need to use the Penn High School Friends & Family selection in the drop and login with the following information:

- 3. Print the permission slip and med forms below at home, or they are attached if you picked it up from school. Fill out the required forms and turn in the forms with \$30 Transportation payment. **ALL Forms, transportation fees, AND Swiss Valley purchases must be completed in order to reserve a spot in the ski club! If we fill up before December 1st, you will not be able to participate by taking the bus. This is IMPORTANT TO NOTE! Checks should be made out to Penn High School. 5. Pay the bookstore \$30 for transportation fees and leave the receipt in the bookstore with 1 & 2 forms

TRANSPORTATION:

On Ski Club nights, buses will leave Penn Door A by 4:30 p.m. and will return by approximately10 p.m. Rides should be at Penn by 9:50 or DQ by 9:30p.m, NOTE: It is very important that ski club members are ready to board the bus on time from Penn/DQ and Swiss Valley. We may not have food or beverages on the bus. Students should eat their snack before we load the buses to or from Swiss Valley.

NEW THIS YEAR all cards have RFID technology and are called MEDIA cards:

The new Media/RFID card is replaceable but is \$20. Do NOT lose this card-it is like cash! If you do not have your Ski Club Card with you when you arrive at Swiss Valley, you will have to pay the \$20 replacement fee. The media/RFID cards are new this year, and they are what allow you to ride the lifts. YOU MUST HAVE IT WITH YOU WHILE YOU SKI AT ALL TIMES!
